Re-editing Gaza's future together

The shaky truce lasted less than two months, before the Israeli bombardment of Gaza resumed. The Zionist entity-refracted by the erratic Trump presidency-restarts with the same ferocity the project of 'overt' genocide that has burdened the Palestinians of the strip since October 2023. In the West Bank, it is business as usual: the pressure of occupation and the settlers' rampaging has never stopped.

This new development does not surprise us. We have learned to read the criminal posture of Netanyahu and his gang: a bunch of unrepentant fascists, thirsty for blood and Palestinian territory. We know they will continue their genocidal project with impunity. It is up to us to make every effort to foil their plan, remaining as ever in listening to the sisters and brothers of Gaza, adapting our contribution to the needs they signal to us on a daily basis. In this new scenario, although our goal remains 'to rebuild Gaza's future together', we are forced to keep the emergency active, to stem the devastating impact that the renewed aggression underway is having on the Gaza Strip and the occupied territories.

The 100x100 campaign will direct its action with due flexibility, responsibly calibrating its intervention priorities in relation to unfolding events.

We will keep these pages updated in order to share the information coming to us from the territory, animated* by that love that will never end

Italian Cultural Exchange Centre Vik has been active in Gaza for over a decade. A place open to all and everyone that has allowed hundreds of young and very young people to find the space to experiment and find their bearings while growing up. A place free and open to contamination, where one can decide one's own destiny autonomously, without impositions from above. Currently, the physical space in Gaza City that houses the Italian Vik Cultural Exchange Centre is uninhabitable. At best, a major investment will be needed to make it functional, although the building that houses it has miraculously remained standing.

It is a lack that is felt. The women and men we work with in Gaza tell us that it is urgent to set up a common space in which to start again. A real meeting point, where the various activities that the **ACS** women and men co-operators, also thanks to the **SOS GAZA** and **EMERGENZA GAZA** donations, have laboriously carried out in these terrible months can converge and resonate. The situation on the ground remains serious and susceptible to sudden and radical changes, but we must move forward. The request of our Palestinian sisters and brothers is not only to be taken into consideration, but to be supported with all our strength.

With the **100x100GAZA** appeal we intend to raise the necessary funds to support the people of Gaza in the social and material rebuilding of their community. Our goal, also thanks to the initiatives that will be put in place, is to reactivate the **Italian Cultural Exchange Centre Vik**, while keeping the ongoing emergency projects active. It will be a path 'in progress', during which we will orient our choices according to the requests coming from Gaza, adapting our intervention to the conditions on the ground.

We do not know what the future of Gaza will be, but we are convinced* that motivation is the first brick of reconstruction: the spark that sets hope in motion again. We invite everyone to work with us so that the people of Gaza can not only continue to resist, but also obtain the social and material means to rebuild their own future.

SOS GAZA



In order to support Gaza and its people, victims of 76 years of occupation, Gaza Freestyle, Mutuo Soccorso Milano, Centro Vik-Vittorio Arrigoni, Acs- Associazione di Cooperazione e Solidarietà, Dis- Donne in Strada e Corte delle Madri launched the crowdfunding campaign SOS GAZA on October 14, 2023. With the donations, we started buying basic supplies such as food, hygiene items, mattresses, canned food and baby food. Over the course of the months, the campaign was articulated with projects proposed and implemented by our collaborators in Gaza.

Normally, the collection of goods and other logistical operations would have been based at the **Vik-Vittorio Arrigoni Cultural Exchange Centre** in Gaza City, but due to the bombing, unfortunately, the physical location is no longer operational.

In addition, in cooperation with a network of local and international associations, we moved to send several containers of humanitarian aid to Gaza, focusing on basic necessities and intimate hygiene items for women and girls.

Mobile camp kitchens

Our manager and his staff have been constantly at work over the past 14 months preparing hundreds of meals a day. They have moved inside the Strip along with the hundreds of thousands of people fleeing the bombed areas

The funds raised are financing activities proposed by women's associations in Gaza, starting with the proposal of the Union of Palestine Women Committees: distribution of hygiene kits and support and listening desks

Gaza Freestyle's online shop, was created because of the need to support the SOS GAZA campaign active since the end of October 2023. For every T-shirt sold, we are able to send 10 euros to our partner and companions who are in the Gaza Strip.

This money will be used to run the popular kitchen, psychosocial activities for orphans, food parcel distributions, filtered water distribution, tents, cartoon screenings on the beach, and a school we are organizing in the Khan Younis area.

Since October 7, we have been sending 20,000 euros per month to Gaza. It is crucial for us to continue these contributions to support the civilian population for as long as necessary.

The roots of an internationalism that we have admired and learned to cherish, to love, and finally to hand down and defend.

EMERGENZA GAZA



Emergenza Gaza is an Italian–Gazawi network of solidarity with the Palestinian people that carries out humanitarian support projects in the Gaza Strip, thanks to the collaboration between multiple Italian organisations and associations and Gazawi collaborators on the ground. The activities in the Gaza Strip are carried out in two parallel ways.

The first are the **interventions**, i.e. defined and self-contained actions aimed at the immediate mitigation of the ongoing humanitarian crisis and repeated cyclically in order to ensure regular support to the population; these are in particular distributions of hot meals and drinking water, mainly in the northern areas of the Strip, which are most damaged and hardly reached by other humanitarian projects.

The second way of working consists of the **projects**: linked to a specific context of action, **Madrasa** (School) and **Saha** (Health), are broader collaborations within which various fixed activities, located in different areas of Gaza and rooted in the territory, are included, aimed at the realisation of a lasting, structured and stable support that can be a point of reference and a space for collaboration and sharing with the local population.



The Projects



SAHA means **health** in Arabic and the project was set up by our Gazawi partners with the aim of intervening in a structured way on the devastating consequences of the latest Israeli aggression on the Strip on the health of its inhabitants.

This is why we are present in the central area of the territory with **5 field clinics** and in the north with itinerant medical examinations run by volunteer doctors and nurses who carry out control activities, monitoring the population's state of health, prevention and awareness-raising.

Another very important area for us is the mental health of the population of Gaza, especially children and minors, so together with ICSPR we carry out psychological support activities for health workers and children through creative workshops and community and relaxation activities.

MADRASA means **school** in Arabic and the project is related to the area of culture and education, one of the most important rights to protect and the most powerful tools to build awareness and resistance to violence and occupation. This is why we have financially supported two educational centres, **Al-Nour** and **Senaat Al-Haya**t, in the central southern part of the Strip which, despite the closure of schools, have been carrying out lessons and recreational workshops that help the children to regain a sense of everyday life and normality put at risk by the military aggression.

Together with others, we launched the 'Ramadan e i libri' campaign, a small independent publisher currently printing educational material for university students and fairy tales for children that are distributed in refugee camp areas to the children of displaced families.

The Interventions



Food distribution

Since the first months after the beginning of the Israeli offensive on Gaza, we have been involved in food distribution and hot meals in different areas of the territory: in the central and southern areas, also thanks to the collaboration with the **Popular Kitchen in Rafah** of the NGO ACS, and autonomously reaching the northern areas, in particular the refugee camp of **Jabalia**, among the most affected by the bombardment and violence of the army.

One of the ways in which Israeli oppression is realised is the isolation of the Gaza Strip and the blocking of resources and supplies at the borders. After months of siege and bombardment, the Strip faces a critical lack of **drinking water**, especially in the northern territories. Therefore, thanks to the commitment and efforts of our partners in Gaza, we carry out several drinking water distributions in the areas of **Gaza City**, **Jabalia and Khan Younis**.

FINACIAL REPORT

SOS GAZA and EMERGENZA GAZA have received no money from public agencies or private calls. The requisites are lacking and only very few organizations agree to work or fund projects in the Strip.

Too difficult to report, too many risks and impossible bureaucracy, lacking any services, and even the minimal emergency coordination usually present during "normal wars."


We have been trying to go on our own legs, self-financing thanks to the contributions of so many, listening to the requests that come from our companions and trying to do our best.

ACS – Associazione di Cooperazione e Solidarietà is a secular, non-profit NGO. For more than 20 years we have been working in critical areas in the South of the World with emergency and sustainable development projects. We work in networks with a view to participatory cooperation, working alongside and supporting local communities and institutions. The philosophy behind our action rejects the exported Western aid approach, in order to pursue a synergetic development objective that aims at the progressive independence of local realities.

Among the various projects promoted, we would like to mention **GREEN HOPES GAZA**, a social and environmental redevelopment project in the northern areas of the Strip submerged by rubbish. The project involved the reclamation of an area of approximately 12,000sqm by redeveloping it into a recreational and green area for the community of Beit Lahia, Beit Hanoun and Jabalya. The project ended on 7 October 2023.

In addition to supporting the **SOS GAZA** campaign, the Veneto-based association has been involved in various projects with a wide range of beneficiaries.

Among them, Gaza Sunbirds, the team of para-cyclists bringing aid to the population of Gaza, deserves special mention. The group founded in 2020 by Alaa al Dali, a professional athlete who lost a leg to Israeli snipers, was preparing for the Paris 2024 Games. Since 7 October, however, it has been collecting goods for civilians in the Strip exhausted by shelling.

GAZA SUNBIRDS

GAZA FREESTYLE



The Gaza Freestyle Festival was born in 2014 under the name Festival of Cultures.

It became in 2017 Gaza Freestyle Festival, what you know today, which is a collective of people divided into five subgroups: the skate group, the women's group, the music group, the media group and the writing group.

Despite the obstacles caused by the occupation, we have managed to enter the Gaza Strip several times since 2018.

The response we have received from the Gazawi people has been very warm, welcoming and productive. Together with them we have completed the first skatepark in the Strip in Gaza City; we have worked with dozens of women's support associations organising workshops and laboratories on sex education, affectivity education and political debate; we have recorded two Italo-Palestinian hip-hop tracks with video clips and we have pursued academic collaborations; we have repainted destroyed houses, prisons and abandoned places to give colour to suffering and we have documented all our activities with videos, photos and articles.

Our group is made up of girls and boys between the ages of 18 and 35, we are working men and women, students, internationalist militants, activists for the right of peoples to self-determination.









PROGETTO REC



Il Progetto REC – Ricerca e Cultura in Palestina was born as a project of solidarity with the palestinian people.

The decision to intervene in Palestine, and in particular in the Gaza Strip, is based on the recognition in that land of the limitation to self-determination of a people oppressed by an increasingly violent and extensive occupation and the concretisation of a mentality, entirely Western, that believes it can decide the lives of entire populations.

We are interested in spreading the reality of Palestine in Italy through the voices of those who live it, breaking away from the mainstream narrative that only describes it as a tormented and hopeless territory. The activities we promote are based on cultural exchange and shared elaboration, through artistic and cultural activities and direct contact with the population to build moments of listening, growth and collective intervention.

In **2022**, in collaboration with **ACS** and the **Vik Centre in Gaza**, we carried out a socio-political research project on the theme of Return and a theatre project within which a group of students from Gaza City developed, wrote and staged the play **All That's Left to Me**.

Our goal was to take the theatre company beyond the Gaza wall and organise an Italian tour of the show in 2023, but the aggression that began after 7 October led to the activation, together with APS Lupo Rosso, APS Scighera, Associazione Culturale Liguria Palestina, AssoPace Palestina, CS CasaLoca, CSA Baraonda, Collettivo Kasciavit, LSOA Buridda e Ya Basta!Milano, of the humanitarian campaign Emergenza Gaza.
